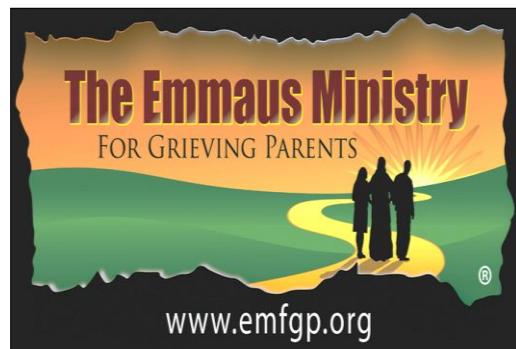
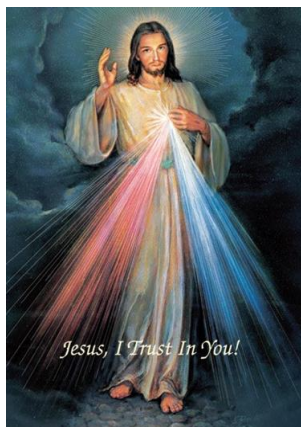
BLESS ME, FATHER, FOR I HAVE SINNED...
